In its 48th year, the event will bring together thousands of technologists, regulators and users from commercial and defense sectors around the world for the largest, most comprehensive conference and trade show focused on the unmanned and autonomous systems industry.

Networking — Connect directly with attendees and speakers on the topics that matter most in 100+ roundtable sessions, source the collective knowledge of XPONENTIAL in the Community Q&A, and expand professional circles through 1:1 conversations.

AUVSI XCELLENCE Awards — Recognize the technologies and operators that are advancing autonomy and promoting the safe adoption of unmanned technologies to save lives and improve the human condition.

Several new features have also been added to enhance the program for XPONENTIAL 2020, including:

I.D.E.A. Workshop — The Inclusion, Diversity + Equity in Autonomy Workshop will provide the data behind why a diversity of people are critical to shaping the future of technology and innovation, and give attendees tools and resources to identify gaps, biases, and blind spots in their tech and teams.

Spotlight Sessions — Look to what's next in unmanned with special sessions that will spotlight important new ideas from unmanned integration, enablement of advanced air mobility (AAM), and the finals of the annual Startup Showdown.

DRONERESPONDERS Global Public Safety Summit — Produced in partnership with AIRT, this track will unite first responders, public safety, emergency services, and disaster response professionals to expand the deployment and capabilities of UAS for emergency operations.

Registration starts at \$20 for an XPO Hall Pass, which includes keynotes and spotlight sessions, and \$279 for a Full Conference Pass giving access to the entire event.
